Overview

Quantum Control's Contract Management module is part of Quantum's comprehensive Finance Suite and allows pricing, terms and conditions to be recorded and applied to orders for both customers and vendors. Fully integrated with all other Quantum modules, the Contract Management feature set is purpose built to support commercial and government programs for Aviation MRO, Logistics, and Distribution. Users can define agreements for multiple end item part numbers within a single contract, and easily see all linked orders where the contract has been applied.

Features

This intuitive module supports defined pricing for multiple MRO activities for a single part number, e.g. Overhaul vs. Repair. Intuitive design allows Billing Groups and Templates to be attached to Contract line items and automatically applied to Work Orders. Master part Pricelines can also be attached to Contract line items and automatically applied to Sales Orders. Exchange terms can also be defined, such as acceptable core part numbers and Core Due Days.

Additionally, the Contract module allows

terms of Warranty to be documented, attached to Contract line items, and then assigned to parts that are sold or repaired (requires the optional Warranty Management module).

Agreed upon payment terms can be configured, while Contract validity is tracked with Start and Expiration dates. User defined status codes can be used to indicate different contract stages, such as active, expired, in negotiation, etc.

Links between Work Orders and Contracts can be assigned, with visibility in both directions. Additional functionality supports government contracting processes by tracking funding. The Document Imaging module integrates as well to allow the storage of relevant scanned documents, files and images.

History grids in both Inventory and Company Management can be configured to display Contracts for part and company records, while the Contract records themselves display linked Work Orders, Work Order Billings, Sales Orders, Purchase Orders and Repair Orders. Tight integration with Quantum Accounting allows for segregation of revenue and cost by contract.
